

THE STAGECOACH TRAVELS THROUGH THE GOTTHARD TUNNEL

ZÜRICH – LUGANO – ZÜRICH – almost like the old days

For many years an original Gotthard stagecoach has been exhibited at the Swiss National Museum in Zurich. It has been an attraction for children and adults alike.

The coach was supposed to be exhibited temporarily at the Museo di Civico di Belle Arti in der Villa Ciani in Lugano. The crucial question was how to move the venerable relict of ancient times over the Alps without damaging it. On this occasion the main challenge was not the drive itself but the loading and the reliable fixation onto the truck. The T-LINK special trailer brought along not only the wooden substructure, which was necessary to lift the coach safely and to fix it onto the truck, but also the stacker for the loading in Zurich and the unloading in Lugano.
